The walk shall begin immediately after 10.30 am mass. We shall walk from the Church to Debdale park, while praying for all God's creatures at intervals.

SACRAMENTAL PROGRAMME: The registration for Children who would make their first Holy Communion next year, will be held on Tuesday 23rd September at 6pm in the Parish hall. Only Parents are needed to attend. Parents who have children who are up to 7 years old but not baptized, should also have them registered so they can be baptized and receive with others.

NEW MULTIPLE DECLARATION FORM: The Diocese have moved all parishes onto a new system for Gift aid, and have asked that all parishioners donating and using gift aid, to please fill in a new multiple declaration form. These forms are available at the back of the Church. Please endeavour to collect a form, fill and bring back as soon as possible. .

The easiest way to donate to the Parish is by standing order. These forms are also available, you just need to fill it in and send to your bank or return to Church. You will still have to fill in a multiple declaration form as well and return to Church to enable the gift aid to be claimed.

Gift aid enables the parish to claim an extra 25p in the pound from the collection. So it is really a big support to us.

At present, the collections are dwindling, averaging about £250.00 a week, and as you can appreciate, it takes a lot more to keep the Church up and running.
